The Early Years Foundation Stage

'Travelling Toy': Each class has a toy that children can take in turns to bring home. Robins will take home on Wednesday and return on Monday. Owls and Kingfishers will take home on Friday and return on Monday. We ask that you write in the diary what the toy has done with you, maybe adding a picture, and bring it back to school to share with the other children. There will be some notes inside the diary to help you.

Reading books: These are sent home when children have reached the necessary stage in their phonics learning.

Key Stage 1
