PARENT/CARER PERMISSION DOCUMENT (Annex 1)

Please sign the front sheet to give permission for the following: Off-Site Visits and Activities.

- a. To take part in school / establishment visits and other off-site activities (including swimming, sporting activities, local and environmental activities,)
- b. To be given first-aid or urgent medical treatment during any establishment / setting visit or activity. I understand that:
 1. I will be informed of the dates and nature of the activities beforehand and will have the opportunity to withdraw this general consent should I wish to do so.
 2. Advance notice will be given if the activity extends beyond the school day so that appropriate arrangements can be made.
 3. Specific permission will be requested for extended journeys, residential visits, adventurous activities and activities for which a charge has been made.
 4. Ineed to ensure the school is kept informed of any medical condition / disability as and when they arise. Photographs and Work Samples As a recognised training school, we give training opportunities to students from Oxford Brookes University and other establishments. This sometimes means that some children's work is photocopied for evidence of the student's work. This evidence never includes the child's name. From time to time, we may use a camera or a video camera to record some aspect of our work. This material never includes a child's full name, although children may be visibly recognisable. The majority of this material is for in-house or parents' information.

Children's work or children working may appear on our web site. Again, no full names are given.

The local press may be invited to take pictures if there has been a particular achievement or if there is a special occasion. In this instance, if names are requested then individual permission will be sought for their publication.

Parent/Carers Use of Cameras and Video Equipment

On occasions, for example sports days, performances, parents/carers may wish to use cameras or video equipment. This should be done with respect to other parents/carers wishes and should, therefore, only be of their own child, and should not be put into the public domain.

Food Tastings

Occasionally children are involved in tasting different foods (for example, when evaluating food stuffs in Design & Technology). Please let the class teacher know if your child has a particular food allergy. You will be notified in advance of when these tastings will take place.

Face paints/Make Up

There may be times, particularly at Christmas, when children will be using face paints or make-up. Once again, please let the class teacher know of any potential reaction. You will be notified in advance of when this will happen.
