Key Areas of Learning

As Geographers we will name and locate the world's 7 continents and five oceans. We will name and locate the 4 countries of the UK.

As scientists we will be looking at plants, identifying and describing the basic structure of common flowering plants, including trees.

As Design Technicians we will design, make and evaluate our own globes.

As Artists we will draw and make animals from different continents, using salt dough.

ENGLISH

Writing-

- ❖ Sentence writing will focus on:
 - A capital letter to start a sentence.
 - Finger spaces in between words.
 - Full stops.

Phonics –

- ❖ We will have daily practise of reading and writing words in our phonics lessons.
- ❖ **Beegu** – We will meet Beegu, a character we will associate with pseudo words (alien words).

MATHS

Number:

- ❖ **Place value within 20** – Count to twenty, forwards and backwards. Count, read and write numbers to 20 in numerals and words. Given a number, identify one more or one less.
- ❖ **Addition and subtraction** – Solve simple one step problems that involve addition and subtraction. Find number pairs within 10.

Geometry:

- ❖ **Shape** – Recognise and name common 2D and 3D shapes.
