Key Areas of Learning

ENGLISH

MATHS

In Maths lessons we will be focusing on the following areas:

- Number and Place Value
- Addition and Subtraction
- Money
- Multiplication and Division.

PHONICS

We will be recapping Phase 5 Phonics before moving onto No Nonsense spelling. See homework to support each week.

Using the Jigsaw PSHE scheme, and our class jigsaw mascot we will learn about:
